System Recap (Crow Chaser) - 3/26/25

We wanted to provide a brief but important update on the recent performance of the <u>Crow</u> <u>Chaser</u> strategy. As of 3/26/25, we're showing a YTD return of -17.10% (net of 2.5% fees), which understandably raises some concern when compared to the S&P 500, currently down -3.20%.

Unfavorable market conditions like the one we're seeing now are challenging—but they're not without precedent. Below are two charts that help provide some historical context for what we're experiencing:

This chart shows daily statistics reflecting our performance over specific periods. We're currently experiencing a -26.72% drawdown, which makes for a frustrating start to the year. That said, it's a good visual reminder of the kind of volatility that can come with this strategy—especially in tougher market environments like the one we're in now.

The chart above shows the rolling returns for the Crow Chaser strategy across different timeframes. While we're currently in a negative three-month rolling return period, that's well within the range of what we've seen historically. Roughly 31% of all three-month rolling periods have been negative, so periods like this are a normal part of the strategy's behavior.

The more encouraging part is how the data improves over time. As shown in the chart, the percentage of profitable periods rises from 69% at three months to 74% at six months—and continues to trend upward with longer holding periods. This pattern reflects the mean-reverting nature of the strategy and reinforces the importance of keeping a longer-term perspective.

These charts are a good reminder that while short-term drawdowns can be uncomfortable, they've been part of the process before. We've managed through similar conditions in the past, and our confidence in the long-term approach behind Crow Chaser remains steady.
